

## **Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 Windows Install Guide**

**October 2012**

The Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 installer contains a Setup Wizard that will allow you to install, modify, or remove the plug-ins required for XDCAM support within the Avid Media Access feature.

A system with multiple Avid applications will only require one installation of the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in.

### **Supported Products**

The Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in supports the following Avid products:

- Avid Media Composer v6.0.x/6.5.x
- Avid Symphony v6.0.x/6.5.x
- NewsCutter v10.0.x/10.5.x

Please note to always uninstall Sony PDZK-MA2 plug-ins prior to uninstalling Avid, and then reinstall the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in after reinstalling Avid products. When installing Avid for the first time, always install all Avid products first and then install the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in afterwards.

## Installation Instructions


If any previous versions of the Sony PDZK-MA2 plug-ins have been installed on the system, please uninstall those plug-ins prior to running the PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in installer.

Close all Avid applications before running the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 installer.


1. Download the appropriate installer for your installed Avid product.
2. Place the *Sony\_PDZK-MA2\_Installer\_v2.1.msi* on the local system.
3. Double click *Sony\_PDZK-MA2\_Installer\_v2.1.msi* to launch the Setup Wizard.
4. Select the Next button.




5. On the next page select accept the terms of the End-User License Agreement.



6. Select the Install button.



7. When the install is complete select the Finish button.




## Repair Install

A repair install can be performed to restore the plug-in files in the event that the files are missing, removed, or damaged for any reason.


1. Place the *Sony\_PDZK-MA2\_Installer\_v2.1.msi* installer on the local system.
2. Double click *Sony\_PDZK-MA2\_Installer\_v2.1.msi* to launch the Setup Wizard.
3. Select the Next button.




4. On the next page select the Repair button icon.



5. On the next page another Repair button will display. Select that button.



6. When the install is complete select the Finish button.



## Modify Install

The Modify option will only be available when the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in has already been installed on the system. The Modify option allows the user to customize whether or not the plug-in is available on the system. Normally this function is not necessary and the Remove or Repair options are recommended.


1. Place the *Sony\_PDZK-MA2\_Installer\_v2.1.msi* on the local system.
2. Double click *Sony\_PDZK-MA2\_Installer\_v2.1.msi* to launch the Setup Wizard.
3. Select the Next button.




4. Select the Modify button icon.




5. Modify the installed features as desired and then select the Next button.



6. Select the Install button on the next page.



7. Then select the Finish button to complete the install.



### Uninstall instructions

This will remove the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in files for all Avid products installed on the system. All Avid applications should be closed before performing the uninstallation of the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-ins.

Please note that by uninstalling/removing the Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-ins from the system, Avid Media Composer, will no longer be able to access Sony XDCAM media imported via the Link to AMA function of Avid.

1. Open the Windows Control Panel
2. Open "Programs and Features"
3. Select "Sony PDZK-MA2 v2.1 plug-in" and select the Uninstall button for this item.
4. Uninstall of the plug-ins is complete.
